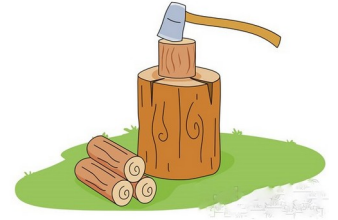

There will be several volunteers plus myself doing security through out the weekend. As a reminder all golf carts, atvs must have a lot number on them. Paper plates are except able to use as lot markers for guest. If your guest brings their own then they also must have your lot number on them. All golf carts must have headlights and at least 1 light in the back. If you are stopped for not having your golf cart or atv lights working you will be told to park it till its fixed. This is for your safety and the safety of others so please comply to these regulations.

All security cameras are working through out the park. These cameras are utilized to help eliminate vandalism and to identify the person involved. The more vandalism we suffer the more it cost the park so please make your guest aware also.

Trash pickup: trash must be out by 4pm. I will be making my rounds to collect it at that time. Please do not leave your trash out overnight. Take to trash containers at the entrance to the park.

Things to remember: any person under the age of 18 must be on their lot by 11pm.

Any issues involving guest will be brought to the attention of the lot owner.

As your Park Manager my first priority is to keep everyone safe. By following the rules and regulations we can make this happen. Please be considerate to your neighbors as quiet hour starts at 11pm.

Overflow parking is available on cedar shores drive marked by signs.
