Dear lot owners,

During the August 15th board meeting the Cedar Shores Board of Directors voted to approve the annual budget for 2021 and raise the annual maintenance fee to \$600. This was a difficult decision to make given the tough economic conditions that many owners are currently facing. It is also the duty of the board to work in the best interest of all owners.

Currently, our operational expenses continue to increase, along with many other expenses including, insurance, contracted services, payroll, permit fees, and capital improvements. If the board were to adopt an identical budget for the next fiscal year, there would not be enough funds to cover all expenses without either reducing services or tapping into the reserve account. The approved budget for 2021 will be available and presented at the annual meeting on September 5th.

It is the board's desire and expectation that Cedar Shores will continue to have a future that can be enjoyed by all.
